

2024 Primary Election Proclamation
Converse County, State of Wyoming

May 15, 2024 - Declaration or Change of Party Deadline for Primary Election

May 16, 2024 – First day for filing application for nomination of election. Federal and State candidates file with the Secretary of State. County and Precinct Committee candidates file with the County Clerk. Municipal candidates file with the City/Town Clerk. Nomination forms [excluding federal, state, and municipal] may be picked up at the County Clerk’s Office.

May 31, 2024 – Last day for filing application for nomination of election.

August 5, 2024 - Last day for VOTER REGISTRATION FOR PRIMARY ELECTION. All voters will be allowed to register to vote but **are not allowed** to change party to vote at the polls on Election Day. If you are unable to vote at the polls, you may vote absentee at the Courthouse beginning **July 23, 2024, 28 days prior** to the election or receive an absentee ballot by mail, or **(July 5, 2024, for UOCAVA voter request only has 45 days)** through the day before the election. A person may register to vote not less than fourteen (14) days before an election **(no party affiliation changes are allowed)** at the Courthouse during the **14-day period** prior to the election, provided you cast your ballot immediately after registering to vote. You may request to receive an absentee ballot by mail, provided you are registered to vote **14-days prior August 5, 2024**, to the election date.

If you require assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write, a person of your choice may help you. If you have questions regarding the accessibility of your polling place, please contact the County Clerk’s Office at 307-358-2244.

August 6, 2024 - (begins) - August 13, 2024 (ends) – Campaign Finance Filing Primary Report.

August 19, 2024 - Minor & Provisional Party Candidate Filing (Deadline)

August 20, 2024 – PRIMARY ELECTION

August 26, 2024 – Independent Candidate Filing (Deadline)

August 30, 2024 – Campaign Finance Filing (Deadline) Primary Report Amendment

October 22, 2024 - (begins) October 29, 2024 (ends) - Campaign Finance Filing General Report.

November 5, 2024 – GENERAL ELECTION

November 15, 2024 – Campaign Finance Filing (Deadline) General Report Amendment

Candidates must file a statement of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures. State or legislative candidates file with the Secretary of State. Candidates for county, municipal, and school districts file with the County Clerk. Candidates for these Special Districts or precinct committeeman/woman candidates are **not required** to file a statement. A candidate who fails to file a full and complete itemized statement within the time required, or exceeds the maximum allowable expenditures, is guilty of a misdemeanor. No such candidate shall receive a certificate of election or nomination, nor shall he/she enter upon the duties of the office and a vacancy shall exist.
