The Glenrock Area Transfer Station and Waste Disposal Area is located at 388 Highway 95 and is free for residents of Converse County, including those living in incorporated towns. Hours are Monday thru Saturday, 8 a.m. -4 p.m., closed holidays.

When using the landfill and transfer station, please consider separating your load prior to arrival as there are specific areas to unload different items. Loads that are not separated prior to arrival will not be accepted after 3 p.m.

The below items are currently being accepted and should be separated in the following areas as follows:
