

RESOLUTION 2012-310

A Resolution Setting Forth the Disconnection and Connection Fees for Water Service

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ROLLING HILLS, WYOMING, THAT:

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Governing Body of the Town of Rolling Hills to disconnect water service to properties for nonpayment; and,

WHEREAS, consumers receiving water service may from time to time choose to have water service to their home disconnected for a period of time; and,

WHEREAS, disconnection and connection fees should be set at a rate sufficient to cover the expenditure of work involved; and,

WHEREAS, per Ordinance 2009-105 disconnection and connection fees shall be set out in Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

a. Consumers who are delinquent on the water account pursuant to Ordinance 2009-105 will have their water service disconnected and a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) shall be applied to the account. To resume services, a connection fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) shall be applied to the account. There will be no service charges to the account while the service is disconnected.

b. Consumers may contact the Town of Rolling Hills and have their water service disconnected. If the service remains disconnected for a period of time greater than one day, a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) shall be charged to their account. If the service remains disconnected for more than one day, no service charges shall be applied to the account while the service is disconnected. Upon request to resume water service, a connection fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) shall be charged to the account, or billed to the consumer, as the case may be.

c. In all matters wherein service has been disconnected, Consumers, or a representative thereof, must be on the premises while service is being reconnected.
