ORDINANCE 2023-163

An Ordinance of the Town of Rolling Hills Amending Ordinance 2019-148 Pertaining to Animal Control

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ROLLING HILLS, **WYOMING:**

Section 3 – Licensing shall be amended as follows:

There is no licensing requirement for dogs.

Section 4 – Tag and Collar shall be entitled "Identification Tag" and amended as follows:

Residents may request an animal identification tag from the Town of Rolling Hills. The Town of Rolling Hills will keep a record of each tag including breed, color and sex, as well as owner contact information, for the purpose of tracking the animal should it be picked up by animal control, law enforcement, or other means.

Section 11 - Release of Detained Animals shall be amended as follows:

If the dog does not have a current rabies tag, the owner, prior to the animal's release. shall present a current rabies vaccination certificate for such animal.
